DEFINITION:

Under general direction to collect and dispose Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) within the City of Burley and to perform other duties as assigned.

CLASS CHARACTERISTICS:

This position class collects and disposes of (MSW) using different equipment and methods. The position requires knowledge of the practices of (MSW) collection and disposal.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Drives garbage collection truck for the collection and disposal of (MSW) and operation and maintenance of related equipment;
- Observes operations involving route scheduling and related activities and suggests improvements;
- Observes safety and training practices in accordance with City and Department goals;
- May work doing alley cleanup and aids in the enforcement of the City's junk ordinance;
- Works efficiently to insure proper and timely completion of routes;
- Operates various types of heavy equipment during times of manpower shortages.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

Principles and methods of equipment, processes, and materials used in collection and disposal of (MSW).

Laws and regulations affecting cleanup of the City.

Skill in:

Driving heavy equipment that requires a Idaho CDL

Exercising sound independent judgement within general policy guidelines.

Establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of the work.

A typical way of gaining the knowledge and skills outlined above is:

Equivalent to graduation from high school and experience in waste collection and equipment maintenance.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Must possess a **Idaho Driver's License, CDL Class B REQUIRED** and have a satisfactory driving record; be willing to work out of doors with exposure to strong smells; must be willing to work in inclement weather and during emergency situations. Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds and repeat the task many times during the day.
