**MINUTES**

1. Goode Motor Community Improvement Projects.

Grayden the representative from Goode Motor was unable to attend the meeting. This item was tabled for another meeting.

2. Rental Charges for Clubhouse.

It was stated that Tracy from Morrey's Steak house had recently met with Scott and Mark to talk about holding banquet events at the clubhouse. Tracy had stated that the Sweetheart Manor was looking at closing and different size groups and events would be looking for facilities. There was no discussion about rates, only a discussion and a look at the facility. Tracy had told Scott and Mark that he would think about it and be in touch.

Mark had sent Scott an email with some ideas on rates. Scott read several different options that Mark had suggested for four-hour use of the facility with and without the use of the kitchen.

Scott had created a list of things that would be needed if they were to start renting out the building such as: chairs, tables, white board, and televisions. There was a discussion of the fact that the facility had no place to store such items and the items had been cut from the budget.

It was suggested that the committee members could get some idea from the Sweetheart Manor and other places that catered to get an idea of what rates should be charged.

The committee discussed how many people could be in the building and what it would look like with social distancing. The liquor license was another item that would have to be discussed further if the club house would be rented out.

3. Golf Pro Compensation. (Referred back to committee by the City Council)

The Committee discussed the history of the Golf Pro, moving the position from a contracted position to a City employee. The Committee reviewed and read minutes and motions from the August 10, 2017 meeting and July 21, 2020 Council Meetings. The committee discussed their responsibilities and the responsibilities of the City Council, the Mayor and Mark in conjunction with the City employees. The letter that Mark sent to the City Council was read and discussed. The Committee felt that no further action was needed by the Recreation Committee.

It was stated that Wednesday noon meetings would be best for the recreation committee to meet in the future.
