New Burley City Wastewater Director



Dustin Raney started in wastewater in 2007 with CH2M HILL, a private contract wastewater operations company, working at the City of Twin Falls Wastewater Treatment Plant. Dustin worked with CH2M HILL for ten years moving up from operator to biosolids coordinator and operations manager.

Dustin came to the City of Burley in 2017 as the Class IV wastewater lead operator and has now been

promoted to the position of Director of Wastewater Services.

Dustin's current licenses include the State of Idaho Class IV Wastewater Operations, Class IV Wastewater Collections, Land Application and he has also obtained a pretreatment certificate from North Carolina. It currently takes eight years of responsible charge experience, and a person must pass four in-depth exams to obtain each of the Class IV Wastewater Licenses. There are currently less than 100 active Class IV Wastewater Treatment Operators in the state and a large number of those individuals are retired or looking to retire in the near future.

It is a good representation of the pride I take in my work. I'm proud to put clean water back into the river to enhance the environment and provide safe recreation of the public."

Sandwich Boards Advertising

The City of Burley code provides for sandwich board advertising only in front of your own business. Sandwich board signs can be no larger than 18 square feet and cannot block any sidewalk, roadway, driveway, or handicapped access structures.

Temporary Special Event Signs

Temporary special events signs and decorations per premises, with the exception of section [4-3-10](#) of this chapter, may be allowed for special events, grand openings, or holidays, limited to a maximum of once every three (3) months. Such signs and decorations may be erected seven (7) days prior to a special event or holiday and shall be removed seven (7) days following the event or holiday. For grand openings, such signs may be used for no more than thirty (30) days. Temporary promotional banners may be displayed for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days. No banner shall be comprised of or incorporated into a rigid structure. No permit or fee is required. (Ord. 1150, 12-19-2000)

Yard Sale Signs

No person shall, within the city limits, paint, post, stick, stamp or otherwise affix or cause same to be done by any other person, any notice, placard, bill, card, poster or advertisement or other device calculated to attract attention of the public, to or upon any sidewalk, curb, curbstone, lamppost, hydrant, shade tree, telegraph or telephone pole, or upon any pole, post or fixture of the fire alarm system or telegraph system, electric light or electric power poles, awnings, barrels or boxes on the public street.

For specifics of sign regulations, please see Burley City Code section 4-4-12 to 4-3-15

Any sign or signs found in non-conformance will be immediately removed and not returned.
